Adobe offers a wide range of creative apps including Painter, Sampler, Designer, Stager and Modeler for 3D design. Additionally, the company has a substantial library of 3D assets available. A free Substance 3D Viewer is currently available in beta, allowing users to import and edit 3D models within Photoshop as Smart Objects. Furthermore, Adobe has integrated Firefly into Substance, providing a text-to-texture and generative background feature. InDesign is a popular page layout tool used primarily for print, but also offers digital publishing capabilities. It's the industry standard for graphic designers and production artists to create various materials such as posters, flyers, brochures, magazines, and ebooks. Lightroom is a suite of tools focused on image organization and photo editing. While it doesn't offer all the features found in Photoshop, its simplicity makes it easier to use for basic photo editing tasks like adjusting curves and hue, saturation, and luminance. For video editing, Adobe Premiere Pro is a comprehensive tool used widely in the film and TV industry as well as by YouTubers and marketing studios. Its advanced features include Auto Reframe and the ability to snap graphic elements to guides or tracked items. Additionally, Adobe has released Premiere Rush, a more lightweight video editing app for beginners and casual users. The latest version also includes AI tools like Firefly, which can clean up audio transcription and extend footage, as well as Generative Video capabilities that turn text prompts into short clips. Adobe Software List Includes Fresco, Premiere Rush, Dimension and Dreamweaver Adobe now offers a range of AI features including text effects in its assets.
